GREEN GLOBE


This variety is improved from the original, the flower buds are deep green with light purple tinge. A good harvest of 3-4 heads can be expected. In addition to its delicious taste it has vigorous foliage.



IMPERIAL STAR

This variety is perfect for those who want to grow it as an annual. Grey-green foliage plants, very tall, buds are 4 1/2 inches in diameter. Mild tasting, this plant will produce nearly 3 times more artichokes in a single season than older varieties. Flower buds are round and thorn-less.

ASPARAGUS





MARY WASHINGTON

This popular variety produces long green spears, and has been the most popular asparagus in America for over a century. It's open pollinated and was developed in California and introduced by the United States Department of Agriculture in 1949.



UC-157 F1

UC-157 F1 was developed at the University of California, and is the most widely planted fresh market variety in the world. It can be harvested longer in higher temperatures. Tolerant to Rust and Fusarium and free of Asparagus Latent Virus 2.



UC-157 F2

Developed at the University of California, the F2 is the second-generation hybrid produced from the original UC-157. It shows earliness in production, uniform color and size, and heavier yield.

BEAN-BUSH GREEN POD





BLUE LAKE 274

This variety has good flavor and tenderness. It is an upright bush, and very prolific worldwide. Produces most of its harvest within a few weeks. Resists Bean Mosaic Virus.



CONTENDER

This variety is one of the best bush beans ever. It's a heavy cropper with round/oval pods and has a strong, distinct flavor. Mildew tolerant, and great for short season and hot weather.



HARVESTER

The Harvester bean variety has tender pods. The bean pods are high off the ground for easy picking. Worldwide demand, and good quality for fresh market.



PROVIDER

This variety is home gardens, local market, shipping fresh and for freezing. Its pods are round to heart shaped. Good flavor, high yields, and widely adaptable.



SLENDERETTE

The Slenderette bean is slow to become fibrous. It's very prolific and the perfect variety for fresh market. Resistant to Common Bean Mosaic, Pod Mottle and Curly Top Virus.

BEET





EARLY WONDER TALL TOP

Our most popular beet. Adaptable to all seasons, deep red globes, vigorous growth in cool soils. Tall, bright glossy green and slightly flattened red roots.



CROSBY'S EGYPTAN

Early tender and very tasty. Prefers light, sandy loam soils. One of the best varieties for early market.



CYLINDRA

This variety is most famous for slicing, with its long cylindrical roots. It produces much more uniform slices than round beets. It's also known as "Butter Slicer" because of its wonderful texture.



DETROIT DARK RED

This variety is a perfectly rounded beet, with deep red flesh and very sweet. Great for fresh and processing markets.



RUDY QUEEN

These early, round smooth-skinned beets are exceptionally tender, and have deep red bulbs.

BROCCOLI





CAMELOT HY

This worldwide, strongly growing, open field crop, has attractive large, round, blue-green heads. It also boasts a long shelf life. The heads weigh around 600 grams.



CACIQUE HY

The Cacique HY is a semi-erect plant, with little side shoots, green heads and are very tender. The heads weigh around 550 grams. Good shipping and strong tolerance to diseases.



GREEN SPROUTING IMP CALABRESE

This variety is very disease resistant, very hardy and very prolific producer of large dark green heads. It's very easy to grow and can be used for fresh markets or freezing. Matures in approximately 60 to 80 days.



WALTHAM

This variety is a standard type. It's a compact plant that produces 4-8 inch green heads. It has some side shoots. This variety is a great choice for fresh market. High performance in cooler climates.

BUNCHING ONION





TOKYO LONG WHITE

This bunching onion has long, slim, white colored stalks, and a mild and sweet flavor. An excellent producer with moderate Bolt resistance.



KAI

This variety is tolerant to low heat. It's very productive among other summer varieties, with excellent thickening, 3 to 5 inch stalks, and resistant to Alternaria Leaf Spot.



IKAKO

This variety grows in full sun to partial shade. Its tall, upright blue-green thick, 3 to 5 inch cylindrical white stalk. It's very uniform.



NEBUKA

This variety is a splitting onion. It has long, slender white stalks. It's normally quite easy to grow with a minimum level of care.

CABBAGE





FORTUNER

This variety is easy to grow in tropical areas, tolerant to heat and high humidity. High yield, compact head, suitable for long distance shipping. Performs well in poor soil conditions.



MERLOT

This variety is a very attractive looking red cabbage. It's tall globe-shape. About 15Kg in weight. Great for shipping and store.



BRUNSWICK

This is an excellent late season variety. Large, drum shaped heads weighing between 6 - 9 lbs. Stores well for long periods. Good shipper.



COPENHAGEN MARKET IMP

This variety is an early ball-head. It's an excellent cabbage, with heavy yields of 4 to 5 pounds. Round heads.



RED ACRE

This is the best early OP red cabbage variety in the market. It produces globe shaped heads approximately 3lbs in weight. Resistant to Cabbage Yellowing.



MICHIHILI (CHINESE)

This variety is softer, loose leaf, green color to almost white interior leaves with wide flat white ribs. It produces a cylindrical, leafy 16-18 inch conical heads.

CARROT





CONDOR HY

The Condor Hy produces heavy yields of high quality. It has a large cylindrical root shape, deep orange color, tolerant to Foliar diseases due to its vigorous foliage, also tolerant to Alternaria.



MARAVILLA ANDINA

This variety has crisp, rich, orange roots, and high fiber content. This OP variety grows and keeps well in heavier soils. It's a Flakee type.



SUPER FLAKEE

This Flakee variety has strong Foliage, 30 to 40 cm, very productive. Stores well, with root size between 20 to 22 cm and a diameter of 6 to 6.5 c,.



CHANTENAY RED CORED

This variety boasts heavy yields. Can withstand heat. Root sizes of 15 to 17 cm, with a diameter of 6 to 7 cm, deep orange root with red orange ****

CARROT





CHANTENAY ROYAL

This variety has a very uniform shape and color. Its foliage is medium green. Root size is between 16 to 17 cm with a diameter of 6 cm.



DANVERS

This variety also presents a very uniform interior color. Ideal for processing and fresh markets. Root size is 18 cm with a diameter of 6cm.



IMPERATOR 58

This variety has a very sweet and tender flavor. It has a deep orange color root, and an average size between 18 to 20cm. Very uniform and quite suitable for bunching. Will perform best in a deep, open, well worked soil.



NANTES SCARLET

This variety does well as a bunching carrot and as a storage carrot. Sweet, brilliant orange, cylindrical roots, containing almost no core.

CAULIFLOWER





SNOW BALL HY

A very heat tolerant variety, with outstanding curd quality. Vigorous plant with dark green leaves protecting the curds wheel. 75 - 80 days to maturity.



SNOW HEAD HY

Good leaf cover, vigorous variety providing dense, firm white curds. Strong upright plant with blue-green leaves. Great for fresh and processing markets.



SNOWVALL Y IMPROVED

This variety was introduced by Ferry-Morse Seed. Tasty, snow white 6", dense, heavy heads, with silvery-green leaves curled around the heads, protecting them from the sun.

CELERY

TALL UTAH 52-70

Dark green stalks and a very compact habit. The stalks are tender and crisp, with a divine sweet rich, nutty flavor. This disease-resistant plant produces high quality, broad, bright green stalks.



AMERICAN LONG STANDING SLOW BOLTING

This variety is a tall standing type plant, which is slow in bolting. Plant grows well in mild and subtropical climates. Young leaves have very good aroma. This vigorous plant grows all year long, making it suitable for home gardens and professional growers.

CUCUMBER





POISETT 76

This is one of the best slicing varieties for salads. It's longer, blocky, and perfect for fresh market. Its vines are very disease resistant. Resistant to Downy Mildew, Powdery Mildew, Scab, Angular Leaf Spot and Anthracnose.



MARKETMORE 76

This is a slicer type cucumber. This long slender dark green variety has been the standard for American slicing cucumbers. Resistant to Scab, Cucumber Mosaic Virus, and Mildews.



CALYPSO HY

The Calypso HY produces compact, medium dark green fruit. An excellent pickler. Tolerant to Angular Leaf Spot, Anthracnose, Cucumber Mosaic Virus, Downy Mildew and Powdery Mildew.

EGGPLANT





BLACK BEAUTY

Tender, tasty fruits, this variety loves warm weather, and are damaged by the cold. Earlier than other varieties. It has become the common eggplant we find in markets today.

FLORIDA MARKET

This variety features a very large plant, with large purple bell-shaped fruit. Resistance to Lo Phomopsis tip over, and Bottle Meek.



LONG PURPLE

This variety is a very dark long purple fruit. Its plant grows to 24 to 30 inches and produces 80 oz. more than other eggplant varieties. Great variety for slicing.

ENDIVE





BATAVAN ESCAROLE

Upright, broad smooth dark leaf, with a creamy yellow center. It can be eaten like other greens either fresh as part of a green salad or sautéed or chopped into stews or soups.



GREEN CURLED RUFFEC

A very old Italian variety that produces fine frilly leaves with pale creamy centers. As the plant grows you can harvest the outer leaves leaving the center to continue to grow.

LEEK





ELEFANT

A vigorous grower with long white stalks and contrasting dark blue-green foliage. Strong resistance to leaf diseases.



LARGE AMERICAN FLAG

This variety has 8 to 10 inch white stalks, with blue-green leaves. This variety is a non-bulting, very vigorous plant that matures in about 130 days.



AMERICAN FLAG

This variety has thick blue-green leaves with large white stems. 100 to 110 days to maturity.

LETTUCE





SUPER 59 (ICEBERG)

Medium frame, head and ribs. Dark green leaves with a large bult. Good resistance to Bulting, Pin Rib and Tip Burn. It also has good tolerance to heat and frost. This variety is similar to Great Lakes 659.



GREAT LAKES 659 (ICEBERG)

This variety is widely adaptable, and tolerant to Tip Burn. Performs well under cool conditions. Solid dark green heads.



BLACK SEEDED SIMPSON (CRIOLLA)

Popular variety. One of the most tender and delicately flavored leaf lettuces available. Simpson is well adapted to a wide range of climates.



GRAND RAPIDS (CRIOLLA)


This is a large green leaf lettuce variety which is wavy and curled at the edges. Resistant to Tip Burn. It's crisp and tasty and can be grown in cool climates.



PARRIS ISLAND COS (ROMANA)

Large dark green leaves with upright to cylindrical plant habit. This variety is slow to bolt and its leaf is slightly savoyed.

MELON





EDISTO IMP HY

The Edisto Imp HY is a western shipper. It has a compact cavity with high brix, great yields, good coarse netting, round to slightly oval. It has bright orange flesh, and is an excellent shipper. Tolerant to Fusarium Wilt 0, 1, 2, Powdery Mildew Race 1 and 2, Alternaria and Angular Leaf Spot. Weight: 5 to 6 lbs. 80 – 85 days to Maturity.



JALES BEST JUMBO

This widely popular variety combines excellent flavor with earliness. It's oval shaped, with salmon colored flesh. 80 days to maturity. Fruit weight is 3 to 4 lbs.



HONEY DEW GREEN FLESH

This variety does not feature netting on its rind. The outer skin is smooth and cream-colored while it's flesh is green and sweet. About 120 days to mature. Fruit weight is to 6 lbs.



EDISTO 45

This variety possesses salmon red flesh and is extra sweet. Resistant to Alternaria, Powdery Mildew. This fully netted variety does well in hot, humid conditions. 85 days to maturity. Fruit weight is 3 to 5 lbs.



TOP MARK

This variety is the classic cantaloupe. Fully netted, rich salmon colored flesh and sweet. Oval to round shape. Matures in 90 days. Weighs about 3 to 4 lbs. Resistant to Downey Mildew, Powdery Mildew and Scab. Excellent shipper.

ONION





YELLOW GRANEX PRR (HY)

This variety is a short-day onion, with maturity in 120 to 150 days. It has a semi flat round shoulder, brownish-yellow skin, and is resistant to PRR.



TEXAS 438

Another short-day onion variety, this is an excellent texas grano type that produces uniform bulbs and outstanding yields in warm and tropical areas. Good resistance to PRR. Its bulbs are round shaped.



TEXAS EARLY GRANO 502 PRR

This variety produces large globe shapes that are tolerant to Pink Root Rot. It's a short-day variety, but works well as an indeterminate day variety as well with 175 days to maturity.



WHITE GRANO

This short-day white onion variety will produce large bulbs with low pungency. This variety is tolerant to Pink Root. It requires full sunlight, and is a good variety for fresh and processing market. Relative maturity in 100 days.



SANGRE DE TORO

This variety of onion produces a firm red skinned globe. It is an intermediate day variety that requires full sun. This variety is tolerant to Pink Root disease.

PARSLEY





DARK GREEN ITALIAN

This variety has dark green colored leaves. It's a celery leaf type, that grows vigorous with a strong distinctive parsley flavor.



PARAMOUNT

Known as curled parsley, this variety is easy to grow. It's an excellent seasoning herb that holds its color well. Relative maturity in 70 to 82 days.



CURLED

Triple curled with slightly long stems, this variety is adaptable to bunching. Curled parsley has beautiful dark green leaves for many uses.

RADISH





RED BALL

This is the main variety of radish and the one that comes to everyone's mind when they think of a radish. It's a small ball, red on the outside and white on the inside. Average maturity in 25 to 27 days.



CHAMPION

This variety is smooth and round, with red colored skin and crisp white flesh. Average maturity in 28 days.



COMET

A very popular variety, with ruby red skin and crisp snow white flesh. Its globe and almost perfectly round shape. Average maturity in 25 to 26 days.



CHERRY BELLE

Round, smooth, scarlet colored with white flesh. This variety is easy to grow. Performs wells in cool weather. 22 days to maturity.



CRIMSON GIANT

This variety has globe shaped, deep crimson skin and white flesh. Ready to harvest in 28 to 29 days. Performs well in cool weather. Fruit size is 2 inches.



JAPANSE MINOWAE

This variety has giant white roots, grows to 22 to 24 inches long and 2.5 to 3 inches wide. Sweet and very crisp.

NEW ZEALAND

This open pollinated variety provides copious amounts of leaves for salads and cooking. Maturity in 60 days. This variety performs well in hot weather.



VIROFLY

Big leaves, smooth and deep green in color, this variety is a very fast growing plant. Maturity in 50 days. Cool weather.



FORDHOOK GIANT

This variety is the classic swiss chard with dark green leaves. Thick, tender and heavy yields, even in hot weather. Easy to grow in full sun. Tolerates Partial shade. 60 days to maturity.

SQUASH





CASERTA

American Selection winner in 1949. It's a rich, full flavored zucchini. Fruit is slightly club shaped with mottled striping in olive-green, and dark green. 50 days to maturity. It's a prolific early variety.



ZUCCHINI DARK GREEN

Dark green Italian type, with light green ridges. Sweet taste and crisp texture. Vigorous plant with open habit. 55 days to maturity. Grows best in full sun and average soil.



ZUCCHINI DARK GRAY

High quality gray zucchini. Very good yields. Good shipper, with cylindrical fruit. Maturity in 45 to 65 days.



ZUCCHINI ROUND

A robust bush-type plant. Super-fast growing, has mild flavor. Very heavy producer. Maturity in 45 days. Fruit shape is round to oblong.



SWEET PEPPER



CALIFORNIA WONDER TMR

Standard bell pepper. Thick-walled, blocky pepper, 4 x 3 1/2 inch. Needs full sun. 75 day to maturity. Most of the fruits are 4 lobed. Tolerant to Mosaic Virus.



YOLO WONDER IMPROVED TMR

Green bell pepper, forming 3 – 4 large lobes. Improved strain of California Wonder. Larger and with more Mosaic Virus resistance. Dense foliage protects the fruit against sunscald.



CAYENE LONG RED (HOT)

Use this variety for fresh or processing markets. Fruit size is 1-5 inches. Full sun crop. 75 days to maturity. This variety is used dry and in powdered form.



JALAPENO M (HOT)

This variety is a dark green fruit that matures to dark red color. Full sun crop. Fruit size is 3 inches. 75 days to maturity. Medium hot.



SERRANO (HOT)

This chili pepper is a smaller version of the jalapeño pepper. Similar in color, about 1 to 3 inches. The Serrano variety is perfect for salsas. Maturity in 70 to 80 days.

SERRANIA

The Serrania is a hybrid, Saladette type. It's a large blocky-plum shaped fruit. Determinate, can be used for fresh and processing markets. It's a red colored fruit with very strong vigorous growth. Resistance: V, FF, Sw, P, Ty



AQS 434D

This hybrid Saladette type variety is blocky-plum shaped. Determinate with a vigorous plant. Use for fresh market. High yielding with good plant coverage. Resistance: V, FFF, N, P, Sw, Ty



AQS565D

Hybrid Roma, Determinate, vigorous, strong plant for open field. High quality fruits, very productive. Resistance: V, FFF, N, Sw, Ty.



AQS 787D

Hybrid, Determinate, Roma tomato with strong plant. It's an early variety with multiple production during the entire harvest period. Resistance: V, FF, Sw, Ty.



AQS929I

Hybrid, Indeterminate, Roma tomato good for open and greenhouse production. Produces a bright and intense red colored fruit, with an elongated oval shape. Resistance: V, FFF, N, Sw, P, Ty.

AQS323I

Another Hybrid, Indeterminate, round, Santa Clara type tomato, with medium size cluster, good coverage, good open and greenhouse production. Ideal for long production cycles. Resistance: V, FF, N, Sw, Ty.



RIO GRANDE

This OP variety has a large plant which produces high yields of large red tomatoes. This variety is excellent for fresh market. It can tolerate hot days and cool nights. 77 days to maturity from transplanting.



ROMA VF

This OP variety has a compact plant. Produces paste-type tomatoes. This variety is resistant to Verticillium and Fusarium wilts. Grows well in full sun. 75 days to from transplanting.



FLORDADE

This OP variety tastes great and produces a lot. It's a Determinate plant, with slightly deep globes, and red with green shoulders. 80 days to maturity from transplanting.



RED CHERRY

This super sweet OP cherry tomato is a best seller because of its flavor. Productive and with good looks, it grows well in open field and full sun. It's a Determinate variety that matures in 65 days.

WATERMELON





BLACK DIAMOND

An OP variety, this classic oblong watermelon has a black- green rind covering a bright red, crisp, flavorful flesh. Grows well in full sun. Matures in 75 to 90 days.



CAL SWEET

Most popular OP variety of watermelon, with very dark stripes, fruits are long and blocky. Flesh is dark red, prefers full sun exposure. 90 days to harvest.



CONGO

This OP variety has deep red flesh. It boasts a high sugar content; fruit is oblong, medium-green with dark green stripes. Requires full sun, and about 90 days to maturity.



CHARLESTON GRAY

This OP variety produces a large fruit, light greenish-gray, cylindrical shape. It grows in full sun and reaches maturity in 85 days.



CRIMSON SWEET

Another OP variety that is light green with dark stripes. High sugar content and great flavor. Seeds are small and dark. Grows in full sun, and matures in 80 days.



JUBILEE IMPROVED

Another OP variety with light green rind and dark green stipes. This variety is disease resistant to Fusarium Wilt and Anthracnose. It has red flesh, and needs 95 days to mature.



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
