

The Problem

Did you know that every year 7,000 women die in Argentina from breast cancer?

Of all cancers, breast cancer is the one that kills most women. Our country is 2^{nd} at risk from breast cancer in Latin America, being the most common disease in the world.

Breast cancer *specialists are scarce* in these countries.

Current legislation does not encourage women to have breast imaging screenings.

Education and awareness campaigns are insufficient.

78% of mammography units in Argentina are **analogue.****

If the disease is diagnosed in time, 9 out of 10 women are saved.***




