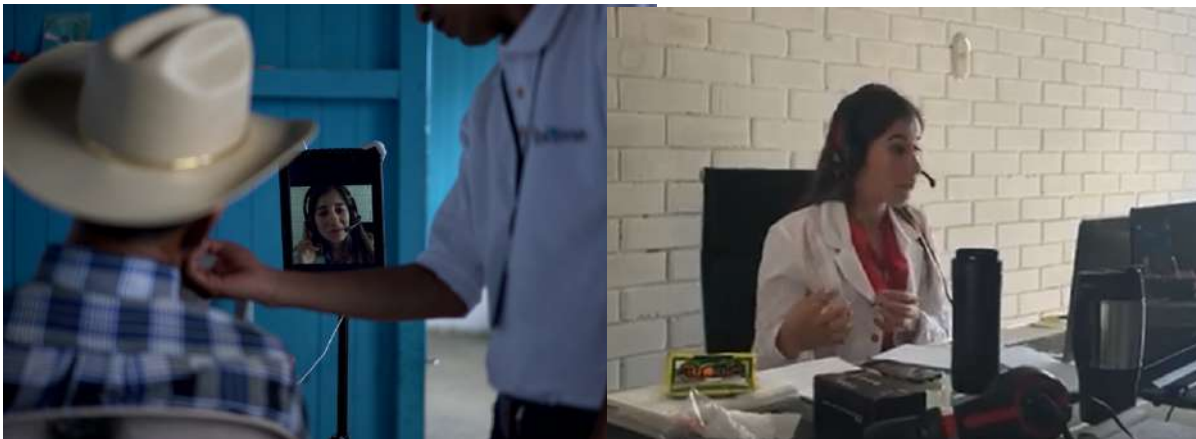
The Problem: Lack of Universal Access to Healthcare in Guatemala

According to the World Health Organization, more than half of the world's population does not have access to quality medical care. In Latin America & the Caribbean, over 165,000,000 people lack access.

The Solution: Bitmec, a Digital Healthcare System

Bitmec is a digital health system that delivers quality, affordable medical care to underserved rural areas. Bitmec consists of three pillars that are connected through an interactive web portal: (i) patients located in rural communities; (ii) a network of community health workers; (iii) a network of remote doctors connected to the Bitmec portal.

Traction

Bitmec conducted a successful initial pilot in Quetzaltenango with its Minimum Viable Product version, in the Guatemalan western highlands. Bitmec tested the functionality of the platform, user experience and potential market acceptance. Since then Bitmec has already launched its Beta version with a first commercial pilot in Western Guatemala with a supermarket chain and the public healthcare system. Bitmec is about to launch two more pilots with major regional renewable energy producers and is currently developing its own diagnostics device in a JDA with Universidad del Valle de Guatemala

Capital-Raising Needs

Bitmec is currently raising a \$500,000 Convertible Note. The use of proceeds will be to fund further software and hardware development activities and roll-out the business at scale with its new commercial pilots including building out a team.
