Bogotá cundinamarca

Bogotá was founded as the capital of the New Kingdom of Granada on August 6, 1538 by the Spanish conqueror Gonzalo Jiménez de Quesada after a tough expedition to the Andes.

It is the third-highest capital in South America (after Quito and La Paz), since it is located at an average of 2,625 meters above sea level. It is located in the center of Colombia, in the natural region known as the Bogotá savanna, which is part of the Cundiboyacense plateau, a formation located in the Eastern Andes.

It has a length of 33 km from south to north, and 16 km from east to west. As a capital, it houses the highest-ranking bodies in the executive branch (Presidency of the Republic), legislative (Colombian Congress) and judicial (Supreme Court of Justice, Constitutional Court, Council of State and the Superior Council of the Judiciary).

According to The Economist, in the economic plane, Bogotá stands out for its economic strength associated with the size of its production, the facilities to create companies and do business, financial maturity, the attraction of global companies and the quality of its human capital. It is the main market in Colombia and the Andean Region, and the first destination for direct foreign investment that reaches Colombia (70%).



MUSEO DEL ORO + BARRIO LA CANDELARIA

Visit to the Plaza de Bolívar here a tour of its surroundings will be made, such as the National Capitol, the Primada Cathedral of Colombia, the Palace of Justice, the Archbishop's Palace, the Liévano Building, the current headquarters of the Mayor's Office of Bogotá, passing by the Nariño Palace, residence officer of the head of state, Palacio de San Carlos, residence and government headquarters of the Liberator Simón Bolívar.



we will walk through the Candelaria neighborhood declared a National Monument with its narrow and steep streets, mansions and balconies that are the legacy and living memory of architecture colonial. We will visit the Sanctuary of Monserrate located at the top of the same name at 3,200 meters above sea level, one of the oldest and most important in the country. The means of mechanical access Cableway or Funicular, make their ascent in the middle of centenary forests of eucalyptus; once at the top, we can contemplate the most impressive panoramic that can be seen of Bogotá. We will visit the Gold Museum that has the collection of Hispanic goldsmiths of the world elaborated in gold and tumbaga, and the exhibition of the different pre-Columbian cultures of Colombia.

TOUR CATEDRAL SAL DE ZIPAQUIRÁ





The Salt Cathedral is located in the City of Zipaquirá, the population of the Department of Cundinamarca, 29 kilometers north of the Capital District of Bogotá, and at an altitude of 2,680 meters above sea level. The population is not only famous for the exploitation of salt, but also for one of the oldest human remains found in Colombia in the El Abra Valley. Although the Cathedral itself becomes the main attraction, it is part of the thematic park El Parque de la Sal, which has an area of 32 hectares and constitutes a unique nature reserve. In the park, visitors can not only admire a surprising encounter between the delicacy of art and the harshness of mining but also get an interesting lesson in geology and ways of conserving natural resources parallel to the development of a country. In this way, the Park, together with the Salt Cathedral, is the target of national and international tourism and is particularly targeted in eco-tourism, religious tourism, and lovers of geological sciences.

VILLA DE LEYVA

Villa de Leyva is a Colombian municipality located in the Ricaurte province of the Boyacá department. It is located 165 km from Bogotá and it was founded in 1572 with the name of Villa de Santa María de Leyva and recognized as a national monument in 1954. It is characterized for preserving a colonial-style architecture, for the variety of its rural landscapes that go from the paramo area, with its springs and water reservoirs, to the desert area, and for the diversity of the species that inhabit them.



But one of the attractions of this place is the great variety of fossils that have been registered by research groups, among which those of a Kronosaurus of 115 million years, found in 1945, stand out; those of an ichthyosaur, 110 to 115 million years old, found during the 1960s, and those of three new pliosaurs, 130 million years old, found in the early years of the 21st century.

The human presence in the region can be dated from 12,000 years B.C. In the 16th century, the Zaquencipá valley was part of the territory of the Muiscas, who occupied the Cundiboyacense plateau in an area of 30,000 km² and whose language was Chibcha.

The Cacique Guatavita lagoon is located in the eastern mountain range of Colombia, in the municipality of Sesquilé, north of the municipal capital of Guatavita, at a distance of 75 km northeast Almeidas de Cundinamarca Bogotá, province. of The lagoon was one of the most sacred of the Muiscas, since the investiture ritual of the new Zipa (Cacique) was performed there; according to legend, he was in a reed raft richly decorated; his body was entirely covered with gold dust; At his feet, they put a large quantity of gold and emeralds to offer to the gods and burning braziers to burn a kind of incense called mogue; the new dignitary was accompanied by four chiefs and when the raft reached the center of the lagoon, the people who were on the shores threw gold objects and precious stones into the water. This is one of the origins of the El Dorado legend. The famous Muisca Raft that is exhibited in the Gold Museum of the Bank of the Republic of Colombia is evidence that this type of ritual was celebrated in the lakes of the region.

Medellín ANTIOQUIA

Medellín is a Colombian municipality, capital of the department of Antioquia. It is the most populous city in the department and the second most populous in the country. It is located in the widest part of the natural region known as Valle de Aburrá, in the central mountain range of the Andes, constituting itself as the largest urban center of such Andean branch. It extends to both banks of the Medellín River, which runs through it from south to north, and is the main nucleus of the Valle de Aburrá metropolitan area. The city has a population of 2,576,452 inhabitants (2020).



MEDELLÍN

During the 19th century, Medellín developed as a dynamic center of commerce, first exporting gold, and later merchandise from the industrialization of the city. As a financial, commercial and industrial center of the country, it is the headquarters of national and international companies in sectors such as textiles, clothing, metal-mechanic, energy, financial, health, telecommunications, construction, automotive, and food, among others.





The most recent survey on the global status of Indra Sistemas' Smart Cities lists Medellín as one of the best cities to live in South America, sharing first place with Santiago de Chile and together with Barcelona and Lisbon in Europe. Medellín won the 2016 Lee Kuan Yew World City Award. The award seeks to recognize and celebrate efforts to foster innovation in urban solutions and sustainable urban development. In 2013 it was chosen as the most innovative city in the world within the framework of the "City of the Year" contest, organized by The Wall Street Journal and Citigroup; to choose this title, an international jury chose Medellín and two other cities as finalists; The final decision was made by a survey open to the public on the Internet. It is considered a global "self-sufficient" type city by the GaWC.



CITY TOUR EN MEDELLÍN

You will visit the replica of a town of yesteryear built in 1978 on Cerro Nutibara, a natural viewpoint of Medellín. It is one of the most important and wellknown hills in the city. It is listed as the largest natural park in the urban perimeter. There are three major tourist attractions in Medellín: El Pueblito Paisa, the open-air theater "Carlos Vieco" and the sculpture park.



This is how Plaza Botero is known: an open-air museum, which shows its perfection in 23 bronze sculptures, surrounded by palm trees that match the blue sky and the multicolored clothes of tourists from all over the world who They visit this place to find something new both the building and the traffic. between city The author is Fernando Botero, Colombian draftsman, painter and sculptor, recognized for using a lot of voluptuousness in his artistic works that arouse curiosity and attention, which leads you to admire "a monumental beauty". The 23 sculptures in the square were donated by the artist Botero and each one represents specific themes. Then figure: Maternity, Woman with fruit, Woman with mirror, Walking man, Sitting woman, Reclining woman, Man on horseback, Roman soldier, Man dressed, Hand, Head, Thought, Adam, Eve, Horse, Dog, Cat, Sphinx, Rapture of Europe, horse with bridles, dressed woman among others. The tradition is that you take a photo with each of the sculptures.
