Tropical Garden

What is it?

Caribbean Botanical Garden is a tourist and scientific-oriented Garden with a huge tropical plants collection of national and foreign tropical plants species. In the Garden, we built several mini gardens with the purpose of showing the importance of specialized gardens such as an orchid garden, a butterfly garden, among others.

Who are we?

We are a Costa Rican technological horticulture small business in which we use techniques like plant propagation in high-tech greenhouses and biotechnology like plant tissue culture to produce orchids for our own gardens. In our orchids production, we control pollination and plant selection and use biotechnology to clone and breed some orchids species and hybrids. This way we can guarantee the quality of the plants exhibited on our Orchid farm, and at the same time, we help preserve the plants in their natural ecosystems. Doing this, we avoid extracting plants from the forests and save them for the enjoyment of future generations.

Details

- The tour includes a fruit bar, fruit juice, coffee or tea and the guidance of a certified tour guide.
- Entrance fee: adults: US \$25, children: US \$15.
- Estimated time of trip: Route 32 San José Guácimo, Limón, by Braulio Carrillo National Park, approximately 1hr and 20 minutes. If you want to visit the Port of Limón, the estimated time from the garden is 1 hr and 30 minutes.

Fauna and Flora

In Caribbean Botanical Garden and nearby areas, there is a great diversity of animals. Among them are birds, mammals, reptiles and insects. There, one can observe the majestic butterfly Morpho (Lepidoptera), as well as different day and night butterflies. Reptiles, such as snakes and lizards live in the garden. Turtles or chelonians are also found there.

The flora is very exuberant with many different and exotic plants. One of the specialties of the garden is the orchids. *Orchidaceae* is the world's most biodiverse family of plants with approximately 25000 to 35 000 species. In Costa Rica there are about 1700 species, and in the garden, one can find *Vanilla*, which is the only orchid used for food. Others are *Guarianthe skinneri*, *Cattleya dowiana*, *Encyplea cordigera*, *Psychosis krameriana*, *Vanda spp*, *Oncidium spp* and many more. There is also a collection of *Heliconias* and ginger or *alpinias*.
