


IIBD

Research & Evaluation	25+ evaluations and assessments completed. IIBD designs and conducts independent evaluations of programs, policies, and institutional practices — producing findings that are credible, evidence-based, and suited to government and multilateral reporting standards.

Our Approach

IIBD applies established, field-tested research methods adapted to the populations and policy contexts we serve. Our engagements are designed to produce findings that are credible, replicable, and directly usable by institutional decision-makers.

Stakeholder Interviews

Structured, semi-structured, and in-depth interviews with government officials, institutional actors, and community representatives. Designed to surface both formal positions and ground-level implementation realities.

Surveys & Quantitative Analysis

Rigorous survey design and quantitative data collection, including sampling frameworks tailored to hard-to-reach populations. Analysis produces statistically grounded findings for policy and program use.

Focus Groups

Facilitated group discussions with targeted community cohorts. Used to gather qualitative evidence on lived experience, institutional barriers, and community-level perceptions that surveys cannot fully capture.

Policy & Document Review

Systematic review and analysis of legal frameworks, institutional policies, program documentation, and regulatory instruments — identifying gaps, inconsistencies, and implementation bottlenecks.
