In this city its summer right when the fishing season opens. Its beautiful rivers, landscapes and breathtaking sunsets offer us a great experience.

The site is very productive for world-class fishing due to many features.

Little access through decades, lack of ancestral fishing technics like barbasco, clear water, water levels drop dramatically on fishing season, catch and release, 20 years of experience in sport fishing and more.

And since 1985 laws that protect peacock bass, sardinata and payara where inforced.

For All this reasons, these rivers hold one of the largest amounts of fresh water sport fishing fish in the world with more than 80 spp.



Fishing it's not recommended the rest of the year because water levels are really high so fish goes away from accessible fishing sites, it's rainy and the rivers become murky.

Our staff is really experienced in these waters, with fishing, driving the motors, knowing the spots, the types of fish, lures, baits, flies.

## **Llanos Fishing Paradise Tour itinerary**

You arrive to Bogotá and we will transfer you to the hotel.

### **Day 1:**

Today we take a short flight 1hr15 min with SATENA airline towards the east, this is an airline which uses an Embraer 145 plane for 70 people in excellent conditions, has one flight a day 6 days a week from Bogota.

Have in mind, 15k for luggage and 5k for carrion allowed.  
Total of 20k.

After landing at P.Carreño, we pick you up right away and then we will get in 4x4 double cabin trucks or jeeps, then we start an incredible 4 hour journey following amazing Guianan shield and savannah landscape with forest patches and granit rocks from the pre-cambrian period, we will see the famous tepuis a word from the indigenous Tumeremo which means sacred land of the gods.

Following “La dignidad” road towards our first settlement called “TAMBORA ecological school”, this was a settlement used by missionaries in the seventies where we are going to spend the first night in basic cabins with private bathroom, the idea is to have lunch on the way and enjoy the scenery.

This is a more basic accommodation which offers double bed rooms, fans, electricity, and mosquito nets available.  
But if you want we can accommodate you in single 3x3mtr tents with mattresses.



We will arrive in the afternoon with enough light and time to prepare fishing equipment and try our first castings from shore on the Orinoco river. Dinner and overnight.

### **Day 2:**

Breakfast around 5 am, and we will get ready to leave Tambora by boat to our magnificent and super comfortable camp site, already set up for us on the Tuparro river, just outside the 1 and a half million acre national park, we will cover around 100 kilometers of river that day fishing all day, if payara and sardinata fishing is requested we can start fishing right away from the boats on the Orinoco and Tomo rivers, then we will keep going pass the national park on the Tuparro river finding spots to try for big peacock bass.

Lunch and cold drinks on the way, and more fishing for peacock bass until we reach our beautiful and comfortable camp site before dark, that way you can unload your bags and get ready for a tasty hot meal and a welcoming drink.

This will be our home for the next few days.

If requested, we can try our first deep water fishing for catfish etc.

### **Day 3/4/5/6/7:**

We will have breakfast at 5 am and board our boats heading to lonely and very little explored areas to try for very big peacock bass and friends.

The idea is to cover secret lakes and sites up river and down river all day, lunch on the go and fishing until arriving to camp before dark for a nice drink and a hot meal.

Every boat will have an ice chest with drinks and snacks.

**Day 8:**

We will leave early in the morning towards Tambora settlement doing the same we did on the way in, fishing all day leaving our comfortable camp behind.

As soon as we hit the Orinoco and some beautiful rapids we will try for sardinata, and the fierce payara its incredible strikes and jumps out of the water.

Lunch on the way and more fishing until we arrive to Tambora before dark for overnight, dinner and some deep water catfish fishing if wanted.

**Day 9:**

Depending on our flight we are able to stay a full day in the Orinoco and Tomo rivers trying for our last chance to be in this beautiful landscape trying to catch payara, sardinata, peacock bass etc.

**Day 10:**

Departure early in the morning from Tambora after breakfast, and drive back to Puerto Carreño straight to the airport to catch our flight back to Bogota, transfers or/and extensions.

**Guests:**

2 per boat

Total on tour a Min of 4 to a max of 6 guests

We can tailor made a 2 guest excursion or a 8+

**Rivers:**

Bitá, Orinoco, Juripe, Tomo and outside Tuparro national park

**Types of fishing:**

Fly fishing, casting, spinning, popping, trolling, and sink bait or deep water fishing.

**Fish expected:**

-The noble and beautiful fight of peacock bass or tucunare, makes him the star of the show, we get three species, (Cichla temensis) biggest one, (Cichla intermedia), (Cichla orinosensis).

-Other target is the silver jumper (Hydrolicus scomberoides) or payara.

-Sardinatas

Yellow sardinata (Pellona castelnaeana) and white sardinata (Pellona flavipinnis.)

**Fishing Plan:**

10 days, 7 nights

8 full days of fishing

**Comfortable camp site:**



Electricity 24 hours, refrigerator, ice, electric outlets, dinning tent, chilling tent, one person 3x3 floor/1 meter 80 high tent, bathroom tent, local cuisine cook, hot meals, cold drinks, full service camp site.

**Notice:**

- Yellow fever vaccine required.
- If our flight is early on the 8<sup>th</sup> day, we will have to leave after lunch on the 7<sup>th</sup> day and spend the night in Puerto Carreño to catch our flight back to Bogota.
- Even though we have never had an emergency, and because we are isolated we have the chance in case of emergency to contact a car by phone or use the national park office to get air support at all times.
- This is a tour designed for great fishermen who want to be comfortable but immerse in nature, where we will see very little or **NO people** at all fishing around us, it can be done throughout the full fishing season and we will be able to experience very big fish and amazing nature.
- Animals we have seen on this trip include: giant otters, macaws, monkeys, capybara, pink river dolphins, toucans etc.

**Included:**

- English speaking fishing guide.
- Accommodation at Puerto Carreño
- Iron or fiberglass Fishing Boats with 40 hp motors.
- Extra experienced motor canoe driver
- Air ticket Bogotá – Puerto Carreño round trip (1:15 minutes one way)



- Fishing permit applicable for any region in Colombia, authorized by AUNAP fishing department and available for a year.
- Cook
- Meals between the tour. (Starting with first lunch in Puerto C.)
- Soft drinks and water on fishing days.
- Travel insurance on fishing days

**Not included:**

- International airfare
- International Airport transfers in Bogotá
- Local airport transfers
- Rods and fishing equipment (ask if available)
- Hotel in Bogotá (ask for assistance)
- Meals in Bogotá (ask for assistance)
- Alcoholic Drinks (ask for assistance)
- Gratuities
- Laundry

Even though we can accommodate any type of allergies or diet requirements. In Colombia generally in this region, people eats the following:

Breakfast: Eggs, Fruit, Bread, crackers, coffee, hot chocolate, arepas, cheese, chorizo, fish and meat.

Lunch: Fish, meat, chicken, rice, plantains, beans, potatoes, vegetables, pasta.

Dinner: Fish, carne a la llanera (typical veal meat or beef put in iron spears around fire), rice, potatoes, beans, vegetables.
