PROBLEM EXTORTION

WHAT DO WE DO?

Since 2011, we rehabilitate people deprived of their liberty through education, work and other activities.

We provide them with training for a dignified reintegration into society.

We do this in the Serigrafía de la Gringa, where the rehabilitated people work in the manufacture of t-shirts and in the printing of arts.

OUR VALUES

- The transparency of the people who make up the project.
- Sincerity and humility in accepting mistakes.

- The confidence of knowing that a person can improve and give a chance to the leadership that lives in each person.

HOW DO WE WORK?

Inside the Preventive:

There is the furniture and machinery necessary to take out the production such as: octopus, industrial plate, flashback, compressor frames, inks, computer equipment, among others.

Prisoners are trained for a period of six months and must complete various educational workshops, focusing on values and leadership, and only those who believe in change and a second chance participate.
