## DENTAL IMPLANTS

A natural tooth consists of a root and a crown. If you compare natural teeth to implant-supported replacement teeth, you'll see they have the same basic parts. Both have a crown (the visible part used to chew food). Both have a root that holds the tooth securely under the gum and is anchored into the jaw. The difference is that the implant is made of titanium – the same time-tested material used by surgeons for artificial joints. For people missing all upper or lower teeth, there are several implant-supported replacement options available.

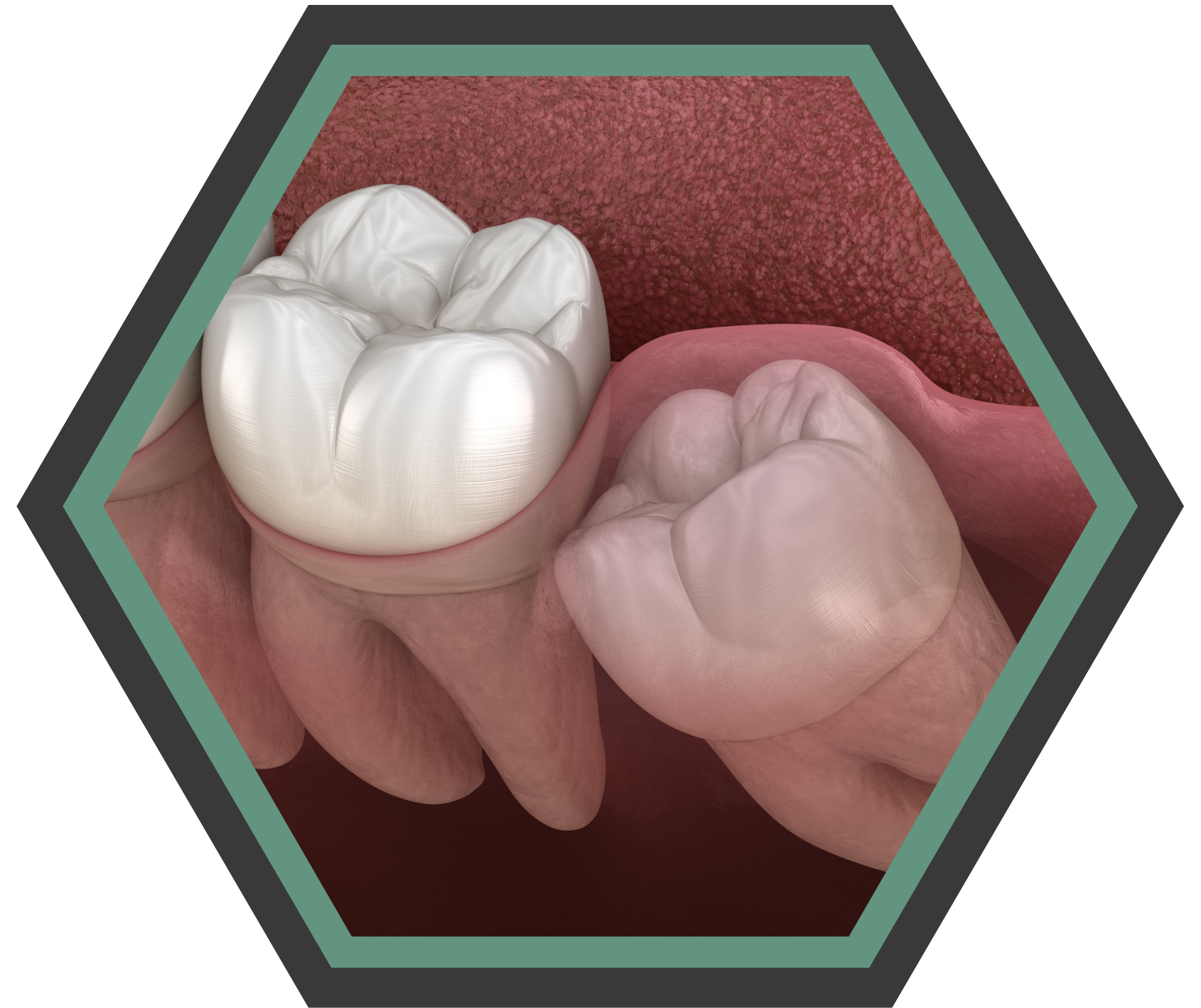




## WISDOM TEETH

Wisdom teeth, or third molars, are the last set of molars to develop in the back of the mouth. They often cause more problems than they're worth, leading to impaction, infection, and damage to surrounding teeth. Removal of wisdom teeth is commonly performed to prevent these complications. If you're experiencing pain or discomfort in the back of your mouth, consult with an oral surgeon to see if wisdom teeth removal is needed.

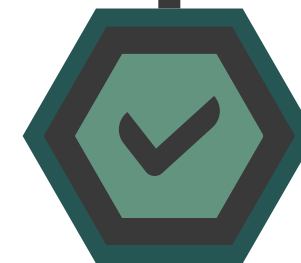
