



WHO WE ARE

In 2025, we joined Brasil Mais Produtivo, a government programme to boost productivity in emerging companies, and Sebrae Proglobal, aimed at expanding Brazilian businesses internationally — with additional support from the Rio's Film Commission's International Co-production Capacity-Building Programme.

At Saraguina Filmes, we embed environmental, social, and governance (ESG) principles across all operations. We are committed to creating audiovisual content with artistic excellence and purpose, aligning creativity with responsibility to drive positive social change.

We work to minimise environmental impact through sustainable materials, efficient waste management, carbon offsetting, and responsible resource use. This commitment is reflected in projects like Serra Fina: Beyond the Ashes (environmental documentary), Time for Global Action (UN SDG-focused series), Artisans du Changement (on sustainable entrepreneurship), and in partnerships with UN Women (female empowerment) and educational platforms such as the University of Algarve and Descomplica.

We actively partner with third-sector and institutional organisations—national and international—to support the impact distribution of documentaries, extending their reach and transformative potential.

Our producers have also participated in and were awarded at Impact Days, the impact lab of FIFDH – the International Film Festival and Forum on Human Rights in Geneva – deepening our engagement with urgent and socially relevant stories.

We engage audiences through accessible, meaningful storytelling; support local communities; and prioritise partnerships aligned with ISO 26000. We act with ethics and transparency, promote diversity and inclusion, uphold human rights, and ensure fair working conditions throughout our production chain.

Socio-environmental responsibility is not only vital to the planet's future, but also to the sustainability of the audiovisual industry. That's why we continually invest in emerging talent, promote best practices in sustainability, diversity, and human rights, and strengthen networks committed to a more just and creative future.
