Over \$70 Billion in Energy Investment

Ohio's natural gas production has been one of the biggest drivers of energy growth in the United States for the last four years. Production from the Utica and Marcellus shale deposits in the Ohio Valley has contributed about 85 percent of the national growth. The large shale production volumes mean access to abundant,

low-cost natural gas and natural gas liquids. Local access to these critical feedstocks is helping those companies that depend on them to expand in Ohio or locate new operations in the state.



"Abundant and low-cost natural gas, butane, ethane, propane and condensate are catching the attention of manufacturers and chemical producers that value low-cost feedstocks, proximity to over 60 percent of the U.S. marketplace and Ohio's business friendly environment. Vast shale resources are attracting many energy investments – from upstream extractors and fractionators/processors to downstream power generators and complex chemical companies."


A Dynamic U.S. State With Global Access


