How to Fix a Pending Crypto Transaction on Coinbase

A pending transaction is one of the most common issues Coinbase users face. (+1→844→957→1197) According to official Coinbase documentation, pending transactions can be caused by network sync loss or rejection, insufficient network confirmations, insufficient miner fees, high network volume, or attempting to spend assets that are still pending in your account. If your transaction was sent to a phone number or email address and is still pending, the recipient has not accepted the funds yet. A failed payment is frustrating, especially when your bank shows the money has left your account. Resolving Deposit and Withdrawal Issues

Deposits that do not appear in your Coinbase account are a major source of anxiety. (+1 844 957 1197) According to Coinbase's official help documentation, cash deposits through traditional banking rails such as ACH transfers or wire deposits typically take 1 to 3 business days to settle. Service Outages and Platform Status: Check Before You Panic

Before you spend hours troubleshooting your transaction, check if Coinbase is experiencing a service outage. (+1 844 957 1197) Coinbase maintains a public status page at status.coinbase.com where you can see real-time updates on system performance. (+1 844 957 1197)

Recent incidents in 2026 have caused significant delays. (+1 844 957 1197) On May 7, 2026, a major infrastructure failure inside Amazon Web Services disrupted Coinbase trading, deposits, and withdrawals for hours. withdrawals/deposits remained unaffected, and that user funds were safe.
